INFORMATION FOR PARENTS (PLEASE READ CAREFULLY)

- Year 12 students are only required to attend school when they have an examination scheduled.
- Supervision will only be provided on these occasions.
- Where a student is unable to report for an examination a parent or carer must contact the school before the examination starts.
- Students who miss a scheduled examination are required to meet with the year advisor to explain the circumstances. They may be given the opportunity to sit for the examination at a later date.
- Students who have satisfied these requirements will then have alternative arrangements made to sit the exam within the examination period, where possible.

INFORMATION FOR STUDENTS (PLEASE READ CAREFULLY)

Prior to the start of the examination:

- Full school uniform must be worn for every exam
- Please pay particular attention to the **starting and finishing times** for your exams
- Report to the exam room 15 minutes before your exams start
- Bags are to be left at the back of the hall away from doorways
- Study notes/summaries must be left in your bag before taking your seat in the examination room
- NO MOBILE PHONES are allowed in the examination room
- Know your examination number. Examination numbers will be posted on the door of the examination room.
- Bring a stapler to ensure your pages are safely secured but do not use it until the exam has finished
- Find out what other equipment is required for all exams and remember to bring it on the day (N.B. Paper is supplied)
- TAFE students are reminded that TAFE lessons continue as usual. If there is an exam clash you
 must organise with your TAFE teacher to miss that lesson

At the start of the examination:

- An attendance slip is to be completed prior to the start of each exam
- Students must attend all examinations in each of their subjects
- Your student examination number must be clearly displayed on the first page and written on every page submitted
- Your name **should not** be written on papers unless specifically directed by the faculty concerned
- All equipment must be available for scrutiny by supervisor

During the examination:

- You must not communicate with or distract other students in an exam room for any reason.
- Sharing equipment with other students is not permitted
- You are not permitted to leave the exam room until the end of the exam

At the end of each examination:

- Question papers as well as answers are to be handed in at the end of all exams
- If your exam finishes before another, leave the hall quietly and do not talk
- Students are advised to occupy their 'free' time in home study
